The Kazakhstan Ministry of Education accredits Nur-Sultan Bilim-Innovation lyceum for gifted girls.

The lyceum was opened in 2003 in the city of Nur-Sultan. In 2017 the Kazakhstan Federation of UNESCO Clubs (KazFUCA) awarded the certificate to the Nur-Sultan Bilim-Innovation lyceum for gifted girls, which confirms the honorary status of a member of UNESCO. Currently, the lyceum is engaged in CIS accreditation.

School information

Type of School:

Non-profit public school executing under the umbrella of «Bilim-Innovation» Foundation, formerly known as KATEV.

Mission:

Our mission is to raise competitive generation in the context of modern education and human values.

The school actively practices value-based education and distributes academic integrity, global citizenship, competitiveness, respect, and continuous development.

Admissions Policy:

- Admission to the school is carried out on the basis of competition in Mathematics, Logic, Kazakh language, and History of Kazakhstan.
- 75 out of 1288 students (6%) were enrolled in the 7th grade in the 2021-2022 academic year.
- In order to qualify for this prestigious and highly competitive award, candidates must score in the top 10% on entrance exams and exhibit a passion for learning.

Contextual Information about the School:

The lyceum is a single-gender secular school located in the urban area of the capital of Kazakhstan, Nur-Sultan (previously Astana). The school has 7-11 grades. The first graduation was in 2008. Almost 400 students have graduated by 2021, who are now studying in 15 different countries.

At present, 684 students are enrolled, who come from business, professional, and government families.



Academics

Curricula Available & Participation Rate: National curriculum (100%). The medium of instruction is both in Kazakh and English languages. Algebra, Geometry, Physics, Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science are delivered in English, while Geography, History of Kazakhstan, World History, Kazakh Language, and Literature are taught in the Kazakh language. Students also study Russian Language and Literature in Russian and Turkish language.
 Ranking: We do not rank.

Grading System & Distribution: Nur-Sultan Bilim-Innovation lyceum for gifted girls had a five-scale assessment system. However, Kazakhstan is now adapting a new criteria-based assessment system for schools, consisting of formative assessment and summative assessment. Its implementation was completed in the 2020-2021 academic year.

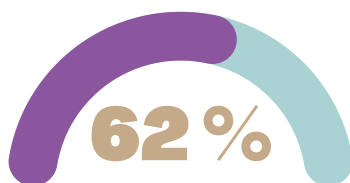

Typical Destinations by Percent:(out of 100%)

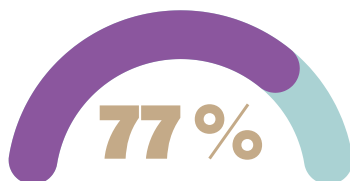
Total amount of grants received by the last graduating class is approximately 246000000 kzt.
